Principal's Report- David Hope

There will be one chance to reorder and incentives of gift cards for kids. The funds will go to school resources. Dave is hoping to have 6-8 parents to help with collection. There should be less bureaucracy with only Mar. 11 needing help fill orders. The extra orders will be sent home before Easter.

Emergency bin- The ID cards have come and will hopefully last 2-3 years. This year they came free. The bins need to be pulled out and update cards, maybe before Spring Break.

Sharing Assembly- The choir is singing but the assembly will be mostly grade group teams sharing evidence of their learning over the past term. It is on Wed., Mar. 4 at 9:00.

Quebec Trip- There was a very low response rate but Dave has decided to move forward anyway. This comes at a cost from roughly \$1900 to \$2300. Only one parent decided not to continue based on the cost change. Camp is April 22.

Hardship- PAC is not funding toward the hardship fund this year but there have been a number of needs lately so the fund is diminished. Dave is putting it back out to PAC to add hardship back in for next year. It would be nice to support those who put a great deal into our school.
