Dear Parents/Guardians of Division 1, 10 and 11,

We have planned an exciting extended day field trip for our Grade 6 and 7 students to Mount Seymour on Thursday, January 12, 2023. Mount Seymour is a mountain located in Mount Seymour Provincial Park in the District of North Vancouver, students will be tubing and snowshoeing.

A ski/snowboard helmet is mandatory for tubing, students **MUST** bring their own.

The cost for this field trip is \$71.00 per student. Our hope is that every student will attend and we do not want finances to be a barrier. If you are in need of financial assistance in order that your child participate, please contact Mme Greenhalgh at the school (egreenhalgh@deltaschools.ca).

Mount Seymour will provide a promo code for a one-day child trail/rental pass, valid for the current season for students who are ill on the day of the field trip, as long as the mountain is provided with a doctor's note.
